



## **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**


Thank you for choosing Ambassador Marine.

Your new Ambassador Marine faucet, sprayer, shower or accessory will give you years of trouble-free performance. Please read these instructions carefully before installing your new item. 










2) Attach the connector hoses to the bottom of the faucet body. Screw the red hose into the left hole (hot inlet) and the blue hose into the right hole (cold inlet), when looking at the faucet body from the front. It is not necessary to use Teflon (plumber's) tape when screwing the hoses into the body, as the o-rings on the tips of the hoses will form a seal.




3) Place the faucet in the hole (1  $^{1}/_{4}$ " to 1  $^{3}/_{8}$ " diameter hole - standard size) of the sink, ensuring the rectangular gasket lines up with the base of the faucet body. Slide the round rubber gasket, mounting support, metal horseshoe washer (ensuring that they all line up together) and then the mounting nut onto the mounting shaft, as illustrated and hand tighten the mounting nut. Position the faucet on the sink. Tighten the mounting nut.



4) Ensure the quick connect housing is screwed all the way onto the pull-out hose. Remove the protective cap covering the o-rings on the male fitting on the end of the mounting shaft. Push the quick connect housing firmly onto the mounting shaft's male fitting, until you feel it "snap" into place. Gently, but firmly pull down on the quick connect housing to ensure that it is properly secured. If the quick connect housing pulls off the mounting shaft, repeat step 3. If it becomes necessary to disconnect the quick connect housing from the mounting shaft after it is secured, simply lift up on the top collar/ring to disengage the quick release while pulling down on the housing.



5) Connect hot and cold water supplies (not provided) to the  $^{1}/^{2}$ " NPS-Male connector hose fittings. Hot supply will connect to the red hose, cold supply will connect to the blue hose. Wrap the  $^{1}/^{2}$ " NPS-Male brass fittings on the connector hoses with Teflon (plumber's) tape. Follow the appropriate steps depending on your water supply lines. If you have pre-assembled water supply hoses with threaded connectors, simply screw on supply lines. If you have plastic water lines with formed ends, water lines will seat partially up into the brass fittings. Connect by tightening the coupling nuts. We do NOT suggest using sweat fittings as they are prone to blow-outs.



6) Pull the spout head a few inches out from the faucet and unscrew the spout head from the pull-out hose. Aim the hose down into the sink. Turn the water supply back on and allow both hot and cold water to run for at least one full minute without the spout head. While water is running, check all connections for leaks. Replace the spout head. Connections may need re-tightening.



A Return Authorization Number is required and must be clearly visible on the the shipping carton.
