





Installation Procedure


Figures 1 - 3









- (1) Hold one of the posts on the wall where desired. With a pencil, lightly trace a circle completely around the base of the post. Remove the post. Hold a mounting bracket directly in the center of the outline (see figure 1). Trace a circle around the mounting bracket and the two mounting screw holes.
- (2) Mount the bracket as shown (see figure 2). If you are mounting into wood, drill a 1/8" starter hole, discard the plastic anchors and attach the bracket to the wall. If you are mounting into plaster, tile, or drywall, drill a 7/32" or 13/64" hole for the plastic anchor. With your hammer, lightly tap the plastic anchors flush into the wall. Attach the bracket.
- (3) Secure the post to the bracket (see figure 3) with the set screw pointing down. Tighten the set screw.
- (4) For the other end, merely set the 24" bar into the mounted post and hold the other post at the correct spot. NOTE: Mount the second post "in" tightly so that there is no side to side movement of the bar. USE A BUBBLE LEVEL TO INSURE THAT THE BAR IS LEVEL. Trace a circle around the second post (see figure 1) and mount.





- (1) Hold one of the posts on the wall where desired. With a pencil, lightly trace a circle completely around the base of the post. Remove the post. Hold a mounting bracket directly in the center of the outline (see figure 1). Trace a circle around the mounting bracket and the two mounting screw holes.
- (2) Mount the bracket as shown (see figure 2). If you are mounting into wood, drill a 1/8" starter hole, discard the plastic anchors and attach the bracket to the wall. If you are mounting into plaster, tile, or drywall, drill a 7/32" or 13/64" hole for the plastic anchor. With your hammer, lightly tap the plastic anchors flush into the wall. Attach the bracket.
- (3) Secure the post to the bracket (see figure 3) with the set screw pointing down. Tighten the set screw.
- (4) For the other end, merely set the spring bar into the mounted post and hold the other post at the correct spot. NOTE: Some tension on the spring bar is desirable to keep it from pulling out of place. Mount the second post slightly "in" to keep tension on the bar. USE A BUBBLE LEVEL TO INSURE THAT THE BAR IS LEVEL. Trace a circle around the second post (see figure 1) and mount.



INSTALLATION PROCEDURE SOAP/LOTION DISPENSER


(1) To fill the soap/lotion dispenser, lift the chrome head and plastic pump out of the neck. Pour in liquid soap (or hand lotion). Replace pump and pump nozzle.

NOTE: If soap (or hand lotion) is too thick, try thinning with some water. Clean plastic pump regularly to avoid clogging. If pump or nozzle become

clogged, lift the head and plastic pump out of the neck. Flush thoroughly with hot water by holding the pump and head separately under the faucet stream. Replace pump and chrome head.




INSTALLATION PROCEDURE TOWEL RING & ROBE HOOK

- (1) Hold the towel ring or robe hook on the wall where desired. With a pencil, lightly trace a circle completely around the base of the post. Remove the towel ring or robe hook. Hold a mounting bracket directly in the center of the outline (see figure 1). Trace a circle around the mounting bracket and the two mounting screw holes.
- (2) Mount the bracket as shown (see figure 2). If you are mounting into wood, drill a 1/8" starter hole, discard the plastic anchors and attach the bracket to the wall. If you are mounting into plaster, tile, or drywall, drill a 7/32" or 13/64" hole for the plastic anchor. With your hammer, lightly tap the plastic anchors flush into the wall. Attach the bracket.
- (3) Secure the towel ring or robe hook to the bracket (see figure 3) with the set screw pointing down. Tighten the set screw.


