

Fitting / Thread Size

\* Understanding <u>1 1/4" Fittings / Threads</u> Although called a "1 1/4" Fitting" or "1 1/4" Thread", which is a standard plumbing pipe thread size in North America, the threads DO NOT actually measure 1 1/4", if measured with a ruler or tape measure.

## **Drain Hole Requirement**

This unit requires a *minimum* of this drain hole 2 1/4" +

1 1/2" Drain

 $1\,1/4"$  is an internationally standardized term, not the true size of the fitting or threads.

"1 1/4 inch" FEMALE pipe fittings / threads actually measure 1.52 inches from the crest (peak) of the threads on one side to the crest of threads on the opposite side



"1  $^{1}$ /4 inch" MALE pipe fittings / threads actually measure 1.62 inches from the crest (peak) of the threads on one side to the crest of threads on the opposite side
